

# Seven Map Proposals Submitted to Wisconsin Supreme Court (Jan. 12, 2024)

Two proposals from conservative groups: Legislature, Johnson

Three proposals from progressive groups: Governor Evers, Clarke, Democratic Senators

Two proposals from groups claiming to use the latest tools in computational redistricting: Wright, Petering (Petering proposal is named "173#008 FastMap Algorithm")

Each proposal (which can be accessed via the URL below) includes one map for Wisconsin's 99 assembly districts + one map for Wisconsin's 33 senate districts

The Petering proposal is the best for nine of the ten metrics of political neutrality that are measured by DavesRedistricting.org, and it is the second best for the tenth metric.





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#### Predicted number of assembly seats won by Democrats (out of 99)




#### Predicted number of senate seats won by Democrats (out of 33)

(Majoritarianism is another metric for political neutrality.)


